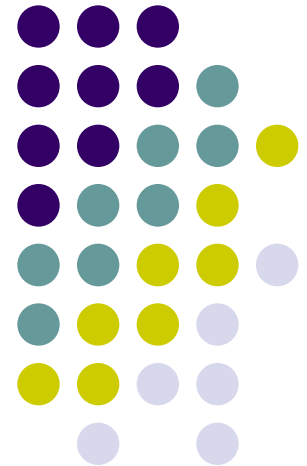

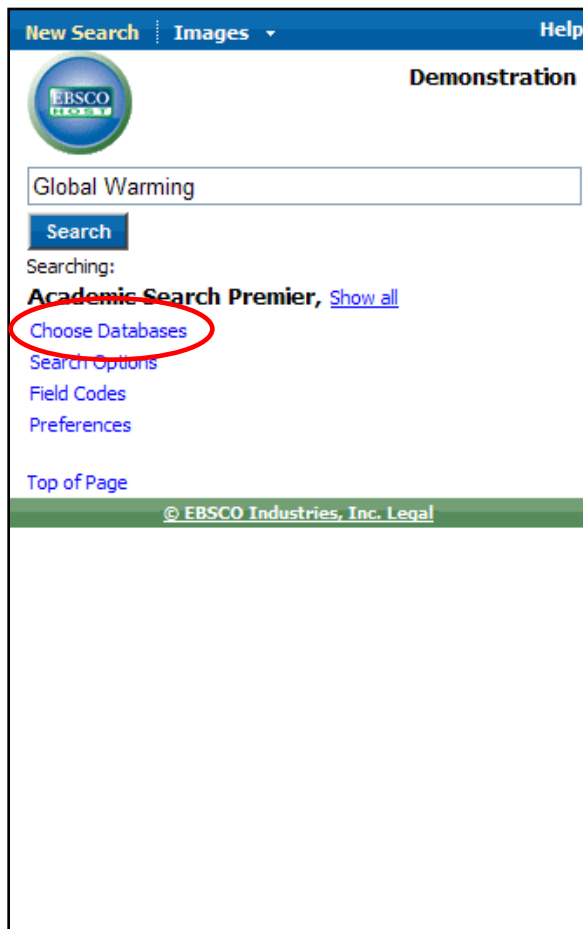

If you are using a device with a touch screen, such as an iPhone, tap the **Find** field to reveal your onscreen keypad and enter your search terms. Make selections by tapping the screen.

If you are using a BlackBerry, navigate to the **Find** field using your trackball and type in the keywords using the keypad. Make selections by pressing the trackball of your device.

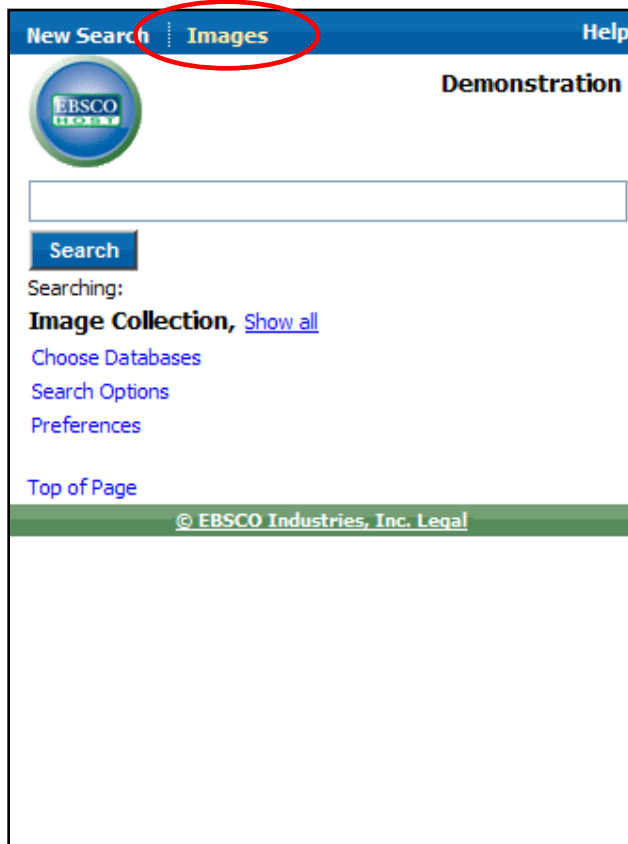



Creating a Search

The Search Screen lets you create a search with Search Modes, limiters, and Boolean operators.


To create a Search:

1. On the Search Screen, enter your search terms in the Find field.
